



Uncompleted Pre-Requisite Coursework

Is it possible for me to complete the pre-requisite requirements after I begin my courses at SCCO?

ALL prerequisite course work **must be completed before beginning classes here at SCCO.**

Orientation, the first day of classes for the first year students, is mid-August of any academic year. All pre-requisite courses must be completed by this date.

All transcripts for these completed pre-requisite courses must be submitted before Orientation. If this is not possible, a written letter from your professor must be submitted on or before Orientation stating that you have completed with course with a grade of "C-" or better.

There are no exceptions to this rule.

Should you be invited to interview, you will receive a written statement of this policy along with a list of the pre-requisite requirements you will need to complete as a condition of your acceptance.

On my OptomCAS application, how do I list course work that I am either currently taking or plan to take?

One of the supplemental questions will allow you to list the coursework you plan to complete and the term in which you will complete it. You do not need to list this coursework anywhere else in the electronic application.

Even though all of my coursework will be finished, my bachelor's degree will not be awarded by mid-August. Can I still apply and start SCCO's program?

To be eligible to matriculate into SCCO's program, a bachelor's degree must be conferred on or before Orientation day in mid August.
