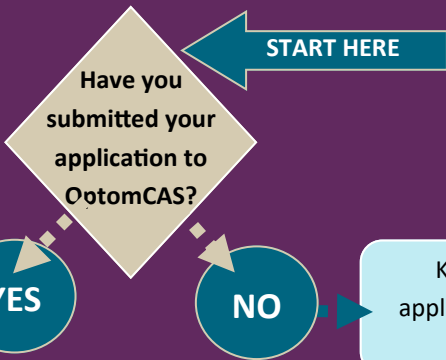

APPLICATION PROCESS

It takes approx. 3-4 weeks for OptomCAS to verify your application before they release it to SCCO. All questions about your application should be directed to OptomCAS during this time. When your application is "verified" and released, SCCO will contact you with information regarding how to pay your \$75 supplemental fee.

Your application has been placed on hold, likely for one of the reasons below. As updates are received, you may be invited to interview.

- Missing OAT scores, or waiting on new scores
- Awaiting an "Academic Update" with Fall grades (update is done through OptomCAS from December– February)
- Applicant does not meet all of the academic minimums to automatically qualify to interview but is still being considered and may be offered an interview later in the season. Secondary review may be required.

Congratulations, you've been offered an interview!
Log into the Portal to schedule your interview and find tips to help you prepare. Interviews are typically conducted one Monday, Friday or Saturday a month. You will find out Monday or Tuesday if you have been offered a seat in the class.

Congratulations, you have been provisionally accepted!
You have 2 weeks to submit the first half of your deposit and initiate your Criminal Background Check (CBC) in order to secure your seat. Once your background check clears, your acceptance will be final!

Not Admitted
If you were on hold and will not be invited to interview you will be notified in the Spring. If you interviewed and were placed on the Alternate List and will not be invited to join the class, notifications will go out after Orientation Day in mid-August.
